Since 1917, San Antonio Winery has won numerous gold medals and international awards for its red wine blends. Inspired by this tradition, Heritage Blanc is an aromatic blend of Viognier, Riesling, Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay, and Pinot Gris. Grown in the ideal climate of California's Central Coast, the grapes are sourced from our family's estate vineyards in Monterey and Paso Robles. Each bottle celebrates San Antonio Winery and the Riboli family.

The quality of the 2011 vintage was excellent. Winemakers Anthony Riboli and Arnaud Debons work closely with multiple vineyards from various districts within Monterey and Paso Robles. Each vineyard lot is cold-fermented separately in stainless steel tanks to preserve the unique flavors of its terroir. After fermentation, the wines gain further complexity from aging in neutral French oak barrels. For 6 months, lees stirring and sur lie aging add richness and body.

Heritage Blanc is a vibrant, mouthfilling wine with excellent freshness, texture, and depth. The nose reveals exotic aromas of rose petals and fresh pear, while the palate shows ripe flavors of lychee and quince.
